

Experimental or AULA PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Canadian Light Aircraft Sales & Services Inc. (CLASS) a Canadian Corporation, is the manufacturer of the BushCaddy Advanced Ultralight and experimental aircrafts kits for homebuilder construction. The undersigned individual, referred to as Purchaser, intends to build and/or fly a BushCaddy t purchased from CLASS, and understands and agrees to the following terms in consideration for purchasing a BushCaddy kit or ready to fly aircraft at standard pricing.

FAA / TC CERTIFICATION

The BushCaddy Homebuilt aircraft requires inspection and certification by Transport Canada and/or their delegates (TC) or the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) under the provisions of the Federal Aviation Regulations (FARs) or Canadian Aviation Regulations (CARS) These regulations limit the use of and who may construct a homebuilt aircraft. Purchaser affirms that he/she thoroughly understands the applicable Aviation Regulations as they apply to the certification of ultra-lights and homebuilt aircraft in the Experimental Category. The purchaser also understands that Advanced Ultra-lights in order to conform to the Certificate of Conformity must adhere strictly to the Design Standards for Advanced Ultra-lights, and no modifications or alterations to the aircraft may be made without permission of CLASS. Purchaser understands and agrees that certification of the BushCaddy aircraft is dependent on Purchaser's construction techniques and resultant airworthiness and applicable Federal Aviation Regulations of the Country of Certification. In the case of aircraft in the Experimental Category, Purchaser understands and agrees that CLASS accepts no responsibility whatsoever for such certification.

AIRCRAFT DESIGN INTEGRITY

Purchaser understands that many factors affect the design integrity of the BushCaddy aircraft, including the design requirements for engine, propeller, and aerodynamic and center-of-gravity characteristics. Purchaser agrees that all components of the BushCaddy aircraft not supplied by CLASS must satisfy all the requirements specified in the BushCaddy literature, assembly manuals and Type Definitions, specifically including requirements for engine size, weight, horsepower, make, and for propeller size, weight and make.

Purchaser agrees to construct the BushCaddy aircraft according to the assembly manual supplied by CLASS Inc. Purchaser agrees that any modification or substitution of any component part of the BushCaddy aircraft kit by Purchaser is made without the consent of CLASS and may make the aircraft unsafe, and may cause the aircraft to not receive Certification.

Experimental and Ultra-light aircraft have not been tested to FAR Part 23 design standards, and may have design characteristics which do not meet FAR Part 23 or which might be considered unsafe. CLASS reserves the right to make recommended revisions in the plans and construction of the aircraft at any time without liability to CLASS. Such revisions may require modifications to completed portions of the aircraft. Purchaser agrees to immediately make any modification to Purchaser's aircraft deemed "mandatory" by CLASS.

LIABILITY

Purchaser understands and agrees that many factors beyond the control of CLASS significantly affect the operational safety of the BushCaddy ultra-light and experimental aircraft, including the quality of the aircraft as constructed by Purchaser or others, the performance of inspections, maintenance procedures and repairs, or the operation of the aircraft. Purchaser accepts sole responsibility for the construction and operation of the BushCaddy aircraft. Purchaser also understands and agrees that the construction, maintenance, and/or repair of any BushCaddy aircraft may involve use of tools, equipment, and construction methods that may present safety hazards, which are beyond the control of CLASS.

Purchaser agrees to RELEASE Canadian Light Aircraft Sales & Services Inc. (CLASS), its owners, employees, agents, and subcontractors, from liability for any bodily injury or property damage arising from the construction, maintenance, or operation of Purchaser's BushCaddy kit and associated options (including liability arising from improper design or manufacture, or from failure to warn of possible dangerous conditions, and Purchaser agrees to IDERNIFY Canadian Light Aircraft Sales & Services Inc. (CLASS) for any such claim from a third party. Purchaser understands that this liability release and indemnification clause is a material factor in determining the price at which Purchaser's aircraft kit is sold, and that the standard cost of a BushCaddy aircraft kit would be substantially higher should such release of liability and indemnification agreement not be made. In recognition of the above, CLASS hereby gives notice to Purchaser and Operators of BushCaddy aircraft that CLASS CARRIES NO LIABILITY INSURANCE.

WARRANTY

The BushCaddy is an experimental or ultra-light aircraft, which has not been tested to FAR Part 23 or other design standards. CLASS does not provide warranty or merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose in regard to the aircraft design. Should any part of the aircraft design prove defective, Purchaser will bear the entire cost of servicing, repair, or correction. CLASS provides a limited warranty to the original purchaser, which warrants that all parts furnished with the BushCaddy kit or associated options, will be manufactured to CLASS's specifications. If any part is not manufactured to CLASS's specifications, or if a component part fails to perform the function intended by CLASS, CLASS will

replace or repair the part, at its option, for one year from date of purchase. Purchaser agrees to pay any shipping charges associated with the repair or replacement of the defective part. In consideration for purchasing a BushCaddy kit and options at standard pricing, Purchaser agrees that CLASS shall have no liability for incidental, consequential, or punitive damages under any express or implied warranty.

PROPRIETARY INFORMATION

Purchaser understands that a BushCaddy kit is supplied to him solely to enable him to construct a BushCaddy aircraft from the kit purchased from CLASS. Purchaser agrees to prevent any BushCaddy kit information from being diverted from its intended use. Purchaser specifically agrees: (a) not to copy or permit others to copy any BushCaddy assembly manuals, (b) not to duplicate or permit others to duplicate any parts supplied to him by CLASS, and (c) not to trace, photograph, or otherwise record dimensional information from parts supplied to him by CLASS or to permit others to do the same.

OWNERSHIP OR CHANGE OF ADDRESS

Purchaser understands and agrees that it may be necessary for CLASS to communicate to BushCaddy builders and operators from time to time. Purchaser agrees to keep CLASS informed of the name and address of any individual who is responsible for the construction or operation of the BushCaddy aircraft constructed from the kit purchased by him. Purchaser also agrees to notify CLASS immediately of the sale of the BushCaddy aircraft constructed by him, whether completed or not, and to promptly supply CLASS with the complete name and address of the new owner.

SHIPPING

All prices are FOB CLASS facilities. CLASS will assure that the proper items are delivered in your kit. It is your responsibility, however, to inventory the parts supplied in your kit against the enclosed parts list. If there are any discrepancies in your order, CLASS must be notified within 30 days of receiving your kit for any necessary adjustments. If any damage has occurred to your kit during shipment, it should be opened and contents inspected prior to acceptance from Carrier, and a statement of damage made to Carrier. Insurance of goods in transit is the responsibility of purchaser, and CLASS accepts no responsibility for goods damaged in transit.

SALES TAX AND DUTIES.

Any kit delivered within Canada is subject to GST. Any kit delivered within the province of Quebec is subject to Provincial Sales Tax. Any kit shipped outside the country of Canada is subject to applicable duties and taxes if any.

PAYMENT AND REFUNDS

Orders for BushCaddy kits are accepted upon receipt of deposit, receipt of signed purchase agreement, and a written acknowledgment of the order (including confirmation of purchase price) by CLASS. Purchaser understands that all prices and kit contents are subject to change without notice prior to acceptance or order. All deposits are applied to the purchase price of the kit, and are non-refundable. **Full payment is due 7 days prior to estimated date of shipment.** All checks are made to Canadian Light Aircraft Sales & Services Inc. Orders for Progressive kits are accepted individually for each kit. Orders are effective upon receipt of deposit for each kit. Deposits for Progressive kits are non-refundable.

DELIVERY DATES

CLASS assigns serial numbers and delivery dates in the order of acceptance. Purchaser understands and agrees that the delivery date is only an estimation, and that actual delivery may be advanced or delayed. Purchaser will be notified if the delivery date can be advanced, and may request within 15 days of initial purchase that it not be so advanced. Delivery dates may be postponed only at the discretion of CLASS. Unless otherwise specified, the purchaser agrees to pay in full for, and take delivery of, the merchandise in not more than two weeks after receiving notification that it is ready for shipment. Storage rental shall be charged beyond that time. Any order not picked up or accepted by buyer, or not delivered for lack of shipping instructions, payments, or any other delays caused by the purchaser for longer than thirty days shall be considered forfeited and void, and CLASS will have the right to dispose of the merchandise at its discretion and retain the full deposit.

This Purchase Agreement is a contract and shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Quebec. The parties acknowledge that the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods shall not apply to this Agreement. The parties hereto have expressly required that the present Agreement, documents and notices relating thereto be drafted in the English language. Light Sport Aircraft PURCHASE AGREEMENT

Canadian Light Aircraft Sales & Services Inc. (CLASS Inc.) a Canadian Corporation, is the manufacturer of the BushCaddy Light Sport Aircraft. The undersigned individual, referred to as Purchaser, intends to build and/or fly a BushCaddy LSA purchased from CLASS, and understands and agrees to the following terms in consideration for purchasing a BushCaddy S-LSA or E-LSA at standard pricing.

FAA / TC CERTIFICATION

The BushCaddy LSA aircraft requires inspection and certification by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) under the provisions of the Federal Aviation Regulations (FARs) These regulations limit the use of and who may fly a Light Sport Aircraft. Purchaser affirms that he/she thoroughly understands the applicable Aviation Regulations as they apply to the certification of Light Sport Aircraft.

The purchaser also understands that Light Sport Aircraft in order to conform to the Declaration of Compliance must adhere strictly to the ASTM Design Standards for Light Sport Aircraft, and no modifications or alterations to the aircraft may be made without permission of CLASS. Purchaser understands and agrees that certification of the BushCaddyE-LSA aircraft is dependent on Purchaser's construction techniques and resultant airworthiness and applicable Federal Aviation Regulations of the Country of Certification. In the case of E-LSA aircraft, Purchaser understands and agrees that CLASS accepts no responsibility whatsoever for such certification.

AIRCRAFT DESIGN INTEGRITY

In consideration for purchasing a BushCaddy Aircraft and options at standard pricing, Purchaser agrees that CLASS

shall have no liability for incidental, consequential, or punitive damages under any express or implied warranty.

Insurance of goods in transit is the responsibility of purchaser, and CLASS accepts no responsibility for goods damaged in transit.
